- Encouragement of a Positive Academic Environment


Outcome of Programme:


- Increased student awareness about the existence and function of the grievance redressal committee.

- Motivated students to actively participate in maintaining a respectful and complaint-free educational environment.




Conclusion: -

- Internal Assessment-related grievances
- University Examination-related grievances
- Mechanisms of lodging grievances
- Roles and responsibilities of the Grievance Committee

Session Highlights:

The session was conducted by Ms. Nikita Barwal, the convener of the Grievance Committee. She provided a comprehensive overview of the types of grievances commonly faced by students and explained the structured mechanism available for resolving them.

1. Internal Assessment-Related Grievances:

- ✓ Issues related to internal marks, practicals, and assignments.
- ✓ Students were advised to first approach the subject teacher or course coordinator.
- ✓ If unresolved, the matter can be formally addressed through a written application to the departmental grievance committee.

2. University Examination-Related Grievances:

- ✓ Concerns about exam results, unfair marking, or delay in result publication.
- ✓ Students should submit a formal application addressed to the Examination Cell.
- ✓ For further unresolved issues, escalation to the University's Examination Controller was discussed.

3. Mechanism of Action – How and Whom to Apply:



Ms. Barwal explained the step-by-step grievance redressal process:

Step 1:

Identify the nature of the grievance.

Step 2:

Draft a written application stating the grievance clearly.

Step 3:

Submit the application to the appropriate authority:

- Internal Assessment Issues: Course Coordinator → Department Head → Grievance Committee.
- University Exam Issues: Examination Cell → University Registrar/Controller.

Step 4:

Await written response or action from the concerned body.

Step 5:

- If dissatisfied, students may appeal to higher authorities or approach the university's ombudsman.
- She also highlighted the importance of maintaining a respectful tone and clear documentation while submitting grievances.

Outcome of the Programme:

- ✓ Students gained clarity about the grievance redressal structure.
- ✓ Encouraged transparent communication between students and faculty.
- ✓ Reinforced the department's commitment to supporting students' academic concerns.

Recommendations


- Conduct such sessions at the beginning of every academic year.


A Report on Awareness Program on Student Grievance Redressal Committee

The programme was informative and interactive. Students actively participated and clarified their doubts regarding the redressal mechanism.



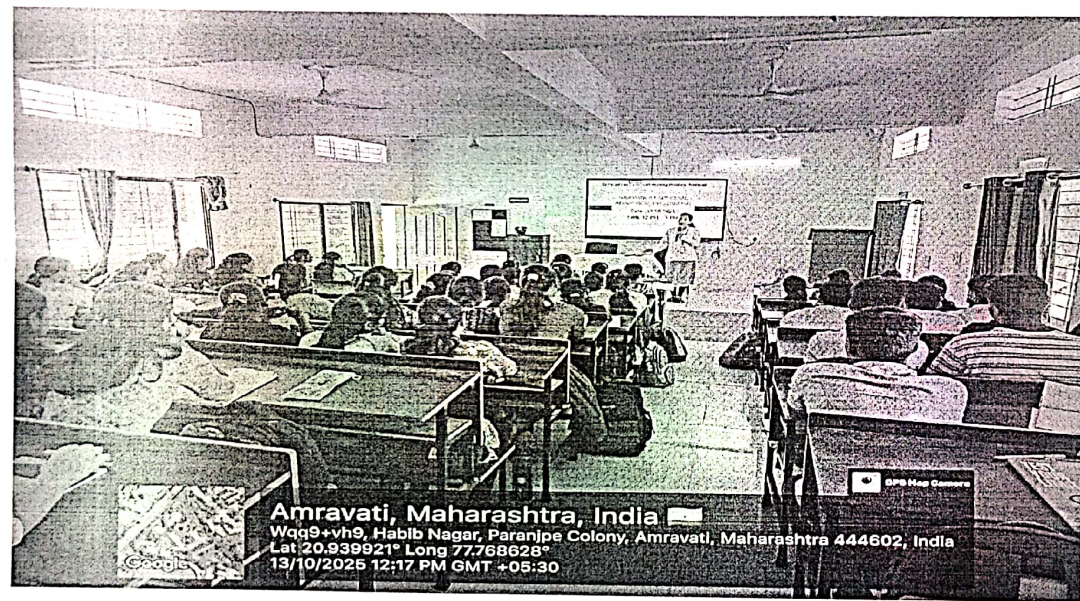
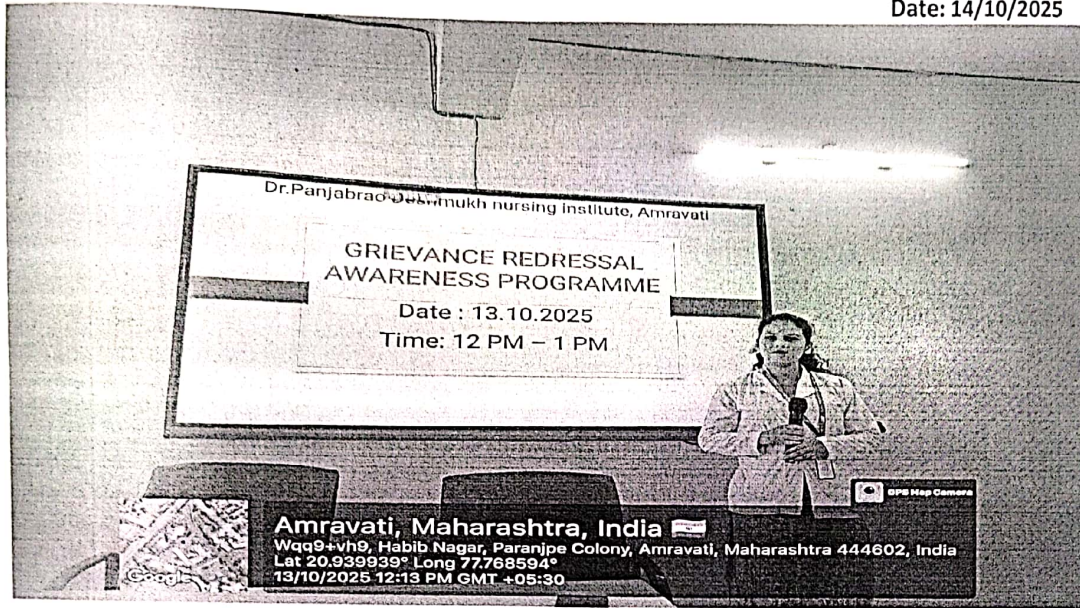
